Through the Doorways to Independence program, ADAPT Community Network provides home modification services and adaptive equipment to persons with disabilities, the elderly, and the medically frail. Funding is available to cover the cost of modifications that will improve physical access and safety within the home. Home owners and renters may qualify for assistance. Home Modifications may include, but are not limited to:

- Wheelchair ramps
- Wheelchair accessible bathrooms
- Stairlifts
- Widening of doorways
- Grab bars and rails
- Shower chairs
- Hoyer lifts
- · Safety fences
- Adaptation for those who are deaf, blind or have low vision
