DESCRIPTION: NYCPS Specialized Programs support students with Individualized Education Plans (IEP) in programs where specialized models have been developed and educators receive specific training to support students learning, social emotional and behavioral needs for students with autism, intellectual disabilities, English Language Learners (ELL) with IEPs, and students requiring intensive social emotional and behavioral interventions and through SEED, an enrichment-based sensory movement program. During this session parents and advocates will learn more about the support provided in these inclusive programs, including academic, social-emotional, communication, behavioral, and sensory. After learning more about these programs, participants will have information to discuss with their school and IEP teams, during evaluations, and learn how to access these programs if they believe they may support their child. These programs are ASD Nest, ASD Horizon, AIMS (Acquisition, Integrated Services, Meaningful Communications, and Social), Academic, Career, and Essential Skills (ACES), Bilingual Special Education, Path Programs and SEED Programs.

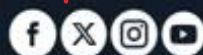
