

Doorways to Independence RESTORE-Emergency Repair Program

Through the Doorways to Independence program, ADAPT Community Network offers Emergency Repair Program through the Residential Emergency Services to Offer Home Repairs to the Elderly (RESTORE) program. The RESTORE Program provides financial assistance to assist senior citizen homeowners with the cost of addressing emergency repairs and code violations that pose a threat to their health and safety or affects the livability of their home.

Emergency repairs may include, but are not limited to:

- Repairs to or replacement of failed HVAC systems and chimneys.
- Stabilization, repair, or replacement of damaged or leaking roof and roof vents and gutters.
- Broken, inoperable or unsecured window or exterior door repair or replacement.
- Repairs to deteriorated interior or exterior stairs and means of egress.
- Other emergency repairs
- Mold remediation
- Electrical repairs or upgrades of electrical/utility systems to remove hazards.

- Service available in all boroughs of NYC
- The owner-occupant must be 60 years of age or older at the time of application and named on the deed.
